

How to get a medical report

To understand more about your child's condition and how we can best support them on the aeromedical transfer, we will need:

- The name and contact details of your child's hospital
- The name and contact details of your child's treating doctor
- A medical report from the hospital

You will need to speak to the doctors or nurses who are looking after your baby to get a medical report. There might be a department in the hospital that deals with overseas visitors, and you might have to pay a fee.

The medical report will need to be a summary of the treatment and care your baby has received to date. The more information we have access to, the better support we can provide. This report helps us plan for their ongoing care back in the UK.

If you have any concerns or queries about the information in the medical report, we will do our best to provide additional context regarding the information you have received.
